Travelling to Jyväskylä

Jyväskylä is located in Finland's Lakeland District, about 270 km (170 miles) north of Finland's capital, Helsinki. You can travel to Jyväskylä by air, train, bus or car. Flights from Helsinki to Jyväskylä are less than one hour (and you connect at the Helsinki airport). The train or car/bus trips from Helsinki are approximately 3.5 hours.



You can reach Jyväskylä by train from Helsinki in even less than 3,5 hours, and from Tampere in 1,5 hours. You can book your train tickets here!

<u>Finnair</u> has flights from Helsinki to Jyväskylä, so you can also continue your trip to Jyväskylä by air. The flight takes less than an hour. Jyväskylä airport is located in Tikkakoski, 23 kilometers from Jyväskylä.

Accommodation

For visitors in Jyväskylä

An excellent variety of accommodation options can be found in the Jyväskylä Region. The city centre offers approximately 1 500 hotel rooms and 2 500 beds. Within a radius of roughly half an hour's drive from Jyväskylä there are plenty of hotel accommodation situated close to nature as well as other options. It also pays to consider traditional Finnish summer cottage style accommodation.

Boutique Hotel Yöpuu

The cosy <u>Hotel Milton</u> is situated in the centre of Jyväskylä in an easily accessible location close to essential services. This privately owned hotel offers excellent value for money. The room price includes breakfast, wireless Internet access and free sauna bath in the evenings, Monday to Friday. Snacks and refreshments are available from the lobby bar. Several restaurants are found in the immediate vicinity of the hotel.


City of Jyväskylä

The Jyväskylä Region is located in the middle of the most beautiful Lakeland Finland and is part of the largest unbroken lake district in Europe. There are over 3 700 lakes shimmering in the Jyväskylä Region, of which the largest one is the Lake Päijänne, the longest lake in Finland.

Jyväskylä in considered to be the capital of Alvar Aalto. The handprint of the internationally known and respected architect and designer Alvar Aalto is more visible in Jyväskylä than anywhere else in the world: in Jyväskylä and in the surrounding areas, there are a total of 29 significant complex of buildings designed by Aalto.

You can find multiple <u>self-guided tours</u> where you can experience the Jyväskylä Region with various thematic routes. They are an opportunity for you to navigate our city through themes you yourself find most interesting. They present the city through a choice of topics, allowing you to explore it at your leisure.

From the self-guided tours we would recommend you to take <u>The Express Route</u>, where you will see the most recognizable landmarks in Jyväskylä, enjoy its university town atmosphere, visit museums and Toivola Old Courtyard, and experience the lively city centre and the relaxed feel of the harbour.



University of Jyväskylä

The University of Jyväskylä is located in a beautiful natural landscape, just outside the centre of Jyväskylä. The university campus areas
Seminaarinmäki, Mattilanniemi and Ylistö form a unique park-like complex that combines old and new.

You can reach the University by walking, biking, train, bus or car. The university campuses are within walking distance of both the city centre and Matkakeskus. You can find University buildings on our map service.

Campus areas are easy to reach by bike. There are plenty of bike parking and bike service points in front of both Agora and Lähde.

If you are arriving by train, Jyväskylä Matkakeskus (Hannikaisenkatu 20) is a convenient access point to the university campus. For example, Seminaarinmäki is only a kilometre away from the train station.

Buses in Jyväskylä run frequently to the campus areas. You can find timetables and routes here.

The University of Jyväskylä campuses will be using the eParking parking application from March 11 2024. For more information about parking spaces on our campuses, parking prices and instructions on how to use the app, please visit our parking page. The nearest parking garage, P-Cygnaeus, is located at Vapaudenkatu 35.

Seminaarinmäki Campus

Our campus is one of the European Heritage sites and it is open to all. Take a campus tour, visit the botanical garden, the University Museum or the University Library, or stop for a coffee or a bite to eat.

The University of Jyväskylä's campus is a unique cultural and natural environment that reflects the history of Finnish architecture for over a hundred years. The campus is known worldwide for its numerous buildings designed by Alvar Aalto. The University of Jyväskylä's Seminaarinmäki campus and equality in education were awarded with the first European Heritage Label in Finland in 2022.

There is a possibility for <u>self-guided garden</u> walk on the Seminaarinmäki campus. The Jyväskylä University Botanical Garden consists of a park of nearly 36 hectares, including the green spaces of the university campus. The outdoor areas are always open to all visitors and plant name plates can be found especially on the Seminaarinmäki campus and in Aalto Park. Welcome to visit the garden and its plant collections!

Finlandia Prize for Architecture-winning <u>Jyväskylä University Library Lähde</u> is a scientific library that is open for public. The library is a modern centre for learning and working and it offers high-quality scientific materials to support studying, teaching and research.




