# Plan for the writing process

# Topic: The ethical and learning-based use of artificial intelligence in the academic writing process

## **Timetable**

### **Day 1** (2 hours)

- **Task:** Define the topic and keywords of the essay precisely. Begin researching basic concepts and theories on the role of artificial intelligence in scientific writing.
- Objective: Come up with a topic and start planning.

### Day 2 (2 hours)

- **Task**: Create search queries and familiarize yourself with the databases available. Begin preparing your information search, find and select three academic articles.
- **Objective**: Selected articles, their storage and recording.

# Day 3 (1-2 hours)

• **Task**: Look through everything and make sure that they are suitable and that you find the right information. If something is not good, you can search for more.

## Day 4 (3 hours)

- Task: Read the first article and take notes on important points.
- Objective: Understand the main points of the article.

### Day 5 (3 hours)

- Task: Read the second article and take notes.
- **Objective**: Understand the main points of the article.

### Days 6-8 (3 days)

• Travelling: No work.

# Day 9 (3 hours)

- Task: Read the third article and take notes.
- **Objective**: Understand the main points of the article.

# Day 10 (2-3 hours)

- Task: Summarize the sources by comparing them: key themes plus points from different sources. Include references to the sources here.
- Objective: I understand the whole picture and how the sources relate to each other.

## Day 11 (2 hours)

- Task: Outline the structure of your essay (main ideas, main points, order of subpoints).

  Write a preliminary plan, i.e., use bullet points to outline the content of each paragraph.
- Objective: Preliminary plan for the essay completed.

# Day 12 (1-2 hours)

- Task: Start drafting your essay, write 1–1.5 pages. Add references as you write.
- Objective: First draft started.

### Day 13 (2 hours)

- Task: Continue writing and drafting your essay (1–2 pages)
- **Objective**: First draft is progressing / almost complete.

### Day 14 (2 hours)

- Task: Read the first draft and think about what works and what could be improved. You could ask for feedback from a classmate or Al! You can start editing now.
- Objective: First review of the text.

### Day 15 (2 hours)

- Task: Second round of editing and finalization begins, e.g., language and sentence structure + stylistic issues.
- Objective: Finalizing the text.

### Day 18 (2 hours)

- **Task**: Review your essay one more time to ensure that all requirements are met and that it is ready to be submitted.
- Objective: Complete essay ready for submission.

### **Summary:**

• Total time: 27–30 hours. If you find that you don't have enough time, prioritize—the most important things are content and structure.
