### 1. Overview and preparation

# Example of the reading process

# 1. Introduction (pp. 31–32)

- 1. Read: Introduction, which presents the background of the article and the research questions.
- 2. Notes: Write down why ChatGPT raises concerns about academic integrity.
- 3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to summarize the main points of the introduction.

### 2. Methods (p. 33)

- 1. Read: The methodology section, which describes how the study was conducted.
- 2. Notes: Write down how the research was conducted and what materials were used.
- 3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to clarify difficult points in the methodology section.

### 3. Results (pp. 33-35)

- 1. Read: Results, presenting the findings of the study.
- 2. Notes: Write down key observations, especially examples of fraudulent use.
- 3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to summarize the main points of the results.

# 4. Discussion and conclusions (pp. 35-37)

- 1. Read: Discussion and conclusions, which consider the significance of the study.
- 2. Notes: Write down how the findings of the study relate to the topic of your essay.
- 3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to help you check your summaries and reflections.
