

Plan for understanding the article

1. Overview and preparation

- Objective: To get an overview of the article and prepare for reading.
- To do:
 1. Read the article's title, summary, and table of contents.
 2. Write down the main themes and keywords of the article (e.g., academic integrity, artificial intelligence, ChatGPT).
 3. Use artificial intelligence (like me) to help summarize the main points of the article.

2. Reading one chapter at a time

- Objective: To delve deeper into the content of the article, one chapter at a time.
- To do:
 1. Divide the article into sections (e.g., introduction, methods, results, discussion).
 2. Read one chapter at a time and take notes on the most important points.
 3. Use artificial intelligence to clarify difficult points or summarize the main points of the chapter you have read.

3. Analysing the key points

- Objective: To gain a deep understanding of the key points of the article and their significance.
- To do:
 1. Focus particularly on points related to the topic of your essay (e.g., the role of artificial intelligence in academic writing and ethical issues).
 2. Write down how the examples and observations in the article relate to the topic of your essay.

4. Summary and reflection

- Objective: Summarize the key findings of the article and reflect on their significance.
- To do:
 1. Write a summary of each chapter and its key findings.
 2. Consider how the content of the article supports the arguments in your essay and what ethical issues it raises.
 3. Ask AI to review your summary and ensure that you have understood the key points correctly.

Example of the reading process

1. Introduction (pp. 31–32)

1. Read: Introduction, which presents the background of the article and the research questions.
2. Notes: Write down why ChatGPT raises concerns about academic integrity.
3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to summarize the main points of the introduction.

2. Methods (p. 33)

1. Read: The methodology section, which describes how the study was conducted.
2. Notes: Write down how the research was conducted and what materials were used.
3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to clarify difficult points in the methodology section.

3. Results (pp. 33–35)

1. Read: Results, presenting the findings of the study.
2. Notes: Write down key observations, especially examples of fraudulent use.
3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to summarize the main points of the results.

4. Discussion and conclusions (pp. 35–37)

1. Read: Discussion and conclusions, which consider the significance of the study.
2. Notes: Write down how the findings of the study relate to the topic of your essay.
3. Artificial intelligence: Ask artificial intelligence to help you check your summaries and reflections.
