


JYU Working Life Path



JYU Internship Voucher

- International degree students studying at JYU
- To Internships included in the degree studies
- Only paid internships 1000 euros/month fulltime internship or 500 euros/month part-time (50%) internship. The voucher is paid to the employer after the internship period (max 2000 euros/student).
- Voucher is paid to the employer after the internship

URAM003 Creating Careers (1 ECTS)



- The course includes
 - 1. Basic expert and working life lectures and webinars (online materials and lecture recordings available at any time during the course)
 - 2. Events with specific dates (both online and traditional events) and separate enrolment (not recorded or available after the date)
 - 3. Workshops (e.g., cv-workshop) with specific dates (both online and traditional classroom workshops) and separate enrolment (not recorded or available after the date)
- The lectures, events, and workshops provide basic information on employment, job search, working life, and work culture in Finland. In the course, students will have an opportunity to improve their job market skills by recognizing personal interests, skills, potential, and networks.
- Completion method: Self-study seven (7) course sessions and final assignment in Moodle.
- Students can select the sessions from the course program according to personal interests.




The multidisciplinary business project course offers you an opportunity to
