HOW TO USE THE THESIS EVALUATION TEMPLATE

The purpose of the evaluation template

• The new thesis evaluation template replaces the old thesis evaluation form. It is based on the new evaluation criteria that were introduced on 1 August 2021.

General principles of the evaluation template

- The template is automated. It will calculate the grade for each criterion, and the overall grade for the thesis, based on the numerical assessment (0–5) given for each sub-section.
- All cells with headings as well as descriptions of criteria and their sub-sections have been locked. Therefore those cannot be edited even by accident.
- Individual sub-sections of the criterion can be left unassessed for a justified reason. For example, if a student has used already existing data, the sub-sections about data collection methods could be left unassessed. The grounds for non-assessment should be written down briefly in the "Comments" field of the criterion.

Grading

- Each sub-section is given a numerical assessment with a whole number (0–5). Half and quarter points must not be used.
- The evaluation template will automatically calculate the average grade for each criterion.
 The average will be calculated from the points of each sub-section and it will be given with two decimal points.

• The evaluation template will calculate the average of the criteria and will give the final grade of the thesis by rounding the average to the closest whole number. For example, if the average of the criteria is 3.20, this will be rounded to grade 3. If the average of the criteria is 3.50, this will be rounded to grade 4.


