



Where to go?



1. Choose the host university based on your
 - language skills
 - field of study
2. Read [exchange reports](#) of those who have been on an exchange
3. Find out about the country's political and security situation.
4. Familiarize yourself with the culture of the host country already during the application phase (take into account, for example, possible challenges related to special diets in the destination country, etc.)
5. Apply for the exchange after careful planning!

Timing



- Anytime after your 1st year of studies (Master's programme student: after your 1st semester)
- Departments/programmes may have their own recommendations
- Discuss the timing with your study advisor
- Include it in your personal study plan
- NB! Semester dates may vary



What does it cost?



Costs

- Traveling
- Room & board
- Insurance and residence permit
- (Local student union fees)
- (Books)
- JYU tuition fee requirement also during exchange!

-> Often you can find information on the costs on the pages of the exchange universities

Financing

- Those eligible for Finnish Study Aid:
 - Study grant (as in Finland)
 - Housing supplement
 - Guarantee for student loan
- University's travel grant
- No tuition fees at the host university
- Accessibility/ (Erasmus) fewer-opportunities grant
- Green travel top-up (Erasmus)



NB! A person who has a valid employment contract with JYU cannot simultaneously be a receiver of grants from JYU. In JYU, remote work from abroad is restricted to 2 weeks, therefore it is not possible to go on exchange while employed by JYU.



Selection results and next steps




- Selection decisions are made within approximately one month after the exchange application period has ended.
- After you have been granted an exchange placement, you will be asked to accept the offered place. Accepting the place is binding.
- Next, your exchange nomination will be sent to the host university, and you will receive a request to complete the host university's application. Timing:
 - For students going on exchange in the autumn: the host application is completed in the spring
 - For students going on exchange in the spring: the host application is completed in the autumn
- We will provide more detailed information about preparing for the exchange during the departure orientation in April.
- If you must cancel your exchange due to, for example, a serious illness, please inform us as early as possible so that we can notify applicants on the waiting list in time.
- Please note that cancelling your exchange without a justified reason after accepting the placement may affect your eligibility in future application rounds.

Green travel



- Consider the environmental impact of your travel
- In order to keep global warming below +2 C:
 - each of us has to limit our carbon footprint to 2300 kg of CO₂ per year,
 - of which only 25% can be allocated for mobility (575 kg)

Green travel: trip to Berlin



- Journey by train and ferry
 - Jyväskylä-Turku (train)
 - Turku-Stockholm (ferry)
 - Stockholm-Berlin (train)
 - Travel time: 31 h 9 min
 - Emission/out- and inbound trip: **480.8 kg CO2-eq**
(-42%)
- Journey by train and plane
 - Jyväskylä-Helsinki (train)
 - Helsinki-Berlin (plane)
 - Travel time: 7 h 8 min
 - Emission/out- and inbound trip: **826.4 kg CO2-eq**

Green(er) travel

- Favor low-emission ways of travel:
 - Train, coaches, shared rides, LNG-ferries
 - If you must fly, favor direct flights or continue your trip after your flight on land
 - Travel in a green way at least in one direction
- During your exchange: Favor getting to know nearby places and use use train, buses, carpooling
- In some cases, green travel is cheaper and/or faster than flying (Nordic countries, the Baltics)
- Enjoy the change of scenery and get to know places you wouldn't otherwise end of visiting



EUROPE



Erasmus+ student exchange (semester/academic year-long)

- For all JYU degree students
- Field-specific placements
- A lot of available placements
- For a semester or an academic year
- Scholarship 490-540 €/month + travel grant based on distance
 - Possibly Green travel top-up
 - Possibly Fewer Opportunities top-up and/or accessibility grant
- You can apply to max 3 universities
- Application period: **21 Jan - 4 Feb**



Erasmus+ accessibility



Fewer opportunities top up for students who:

- have underage children
- are family carers
- have disabilities (min. moderate functional deficiency)
- suffer from a severe or chronic health condition (min. moderate functional deficiency)
- or have received international, subsidiary or temporary protection

Long-term mobility: 250€/30 days, short-term mobility: 100/150€

Special needs and Inclusion support

- special need causes additional costs that are not covered by other sources
- E.g. in cases of injury, impairment, physical or psychological illness or learning difficulty
- Paid in addition to regular mobility grant and it is based on real costs -> good planning is necessary!
Start process at least 6 months prior to exchange!

Erasmus+ mobility grant for green travel

- Eligibility for the grant:
 - At least 50% of the journey counted in distance (not time) to and from the exchange destination has been done by using low-emission forms of travel (e.g. train, bus, carpooling and cycling).
 - Planes and ferries/ships are not considered green, not even if you compensate your carbon footprint.
 - Travelling by ferry is accepted as green travel **when it is combined with other low-emission modes of transportation**
 - Route between Jyväskylä and the destination need to be as direct as possible
- Can be used in all three kinds of E+ mobility: long-term, short-term and traineeship
- Up to 4 extra days for travelling + increased travel grant for green travel

Erasmus+ mobility grant for green travel

- How to apply:
 - Process is part of the Mobility Online workflow
 - You need to create a detailed travel plan (both outward and return) and upload it to Mobility Online
 - We check if the plan fulfils the requirement for green travel and if so, how many extra travel days you can get
- When to apply:
 - Part of the Mobility Online workflow, before preparing the grant agreement
 - Must be done and accepted prior to leaving for your exchange/starting your journey
- International office organizes green travel workshops

- You can apply to Nordlys exchange if your discipline/ department/ faculty does not have a subject-specific Nordplus network
- You can apply to max 2 universities
- Scholarship:
 - Nordplus: depends on the network
 - Nordlys:
 - Erasmus grant 540 €/month in 2025-2026
 - Exception: Nordplus grant for Faroe Islands, 250 €/month + travel grant 660 €
 - Application period: **21 Jan - Feb**

Bilateral exchange



- JYU's own exchange agreements
- Open for all students of JYU
- Exchange universities in North, Central and South America, Asia, Africa and in Australia
- Scholarship: 1500 € - 2500 €
- You can apply to max 2 universities
- NB! Some universities outside Europe (especially in North-America) only available for Bachelor's level students → information can be found in the Mobility Online portal
- Extra application round for the academic year 2026-2027 is open now and ends on **4 Feb**
- Main application round in the autumn
- No extra application round for ISEP this spring

Grants for short-term mobility



- FORTHEM network short-term mobilities, next application round in March for mobilities happening in early autumn 2026
- Nordlys Express grants for 1–3 week studies in the Nordic countries
- Faculty-specific grants:
 - The Faculties of IT, Humanities and Social Sciences, and Mathematics and Science offer grants that students can apply for short-term mobility periods.
- Short-term mobility is especially recommended for students who have fewer opportunities to participate in mobilities
- Students with fewer opportunities and who are required to pay tuition fees may receive a maximum of 2 short-term mobility grants per degree level. Other students may receive 1 short-term mobility grant per degree level.
