- 1. Education and Enlightenment:

 - Advocating enlightenment as a means to bridge societal divides.
- 2. Gender Dynamics & Discrimination:
 - Anecdotes of societal biases both from homeland and in Germany.
 - Discussions on how clothing standards can impact professional opportunities.
- 3. Acceptance & Open-mindedness:
 - A vision for a more inclusive German society and the significance of acceptance.
- 4. Economic Stability & Opportunities:
 - Dialogue on economic adversities, spotlighting the non-acknowledgement of qualifications in Germany.
- 5. Cultural and Religious Practices:
 - Dissection of cultural and religious rites and their role as potential integration barriers.
- 6. Conditions & Needs in Home Countries
 - Accounts of the circumstances left behind, emphasising discrimination, violence, and an urgent call for societal change.

- 1. Societal Pressure & Religious Norms:
 - A comprehensive look into the symbolism of the headscarf, from a mark of modesty to potential imposition.
- 2. Beauty Standards:
 - Insight into stringent Syrian beauty standards and their impact on individual self-worth.
- 3. Power Dynamics & Discrimination:
 - Acknowledgement of differentiation based on heritage, economic standing, and marginalisation encounters.
- 4. Rights and Freedoms in Somalia:
 - Conversations on curtailing women's rights, focusing on education and forced matrimonial practices.

- A collective call for representation, equal rights, and celebrating successful women emerging from their community.
- 6. Integration Challenges:
 - Addressing biases based on origin, linguistic abilities, and differential treatment grounded in attire.

 - Delving into perceived educational system biases, especially against those who aren't native German speakers.
- 8. Seeking Safe Spaces & Understanding
 - The collective plea for welcoming environments in Germany and the essence of shared experiences in tackling discrimination.

Core Themes of Discussions on Community, Identities, Power Dynamics and Intersectionality:

- 1. Community, Identity, and Origin:
 - Exploring fluidity in identity and the significant role of language in community and self-recognition.
- 2. Power Dynamics and Societal Structure:
 - Recognising individual and structural power disparities, especially in institutions like schools and housing.
- 3. Generational Differences and Interpersonal Interactions:
 - The influence of age and personal encounters in forming identity and feelings of belonging.
- 4. The Multifaceted Role of Language:
 - Understanding language as both a unifier and divider in societal interactions.
- 5. Intersectionality, Religion, and Ethnicity:
 - Acknowledging the intertwined nature of identities and the distinct experiences they create.
- 6. Discrimination, Privilege, and Community Dynamics:
 - Navigating shared discriminatory experiences while recognising privileges associated with specific identities.
- 7. Gender Dynamics and Inequality:
 - Investigating gender expectations within ethnic communities and broader societal inequities.
- 8. Perception and Community Interplay:
 - Identifying the underlying "us vs. them" sentiment influencing community interactions and perceptions.
