

Intercultural and multilingual communication in virtual collaborations

The Erasmus Blended Intensive Programme Course Multilingual and Intercultural Communication Competence (MICC) for Virtual Collaborations (3 ECTS) brings together students from around the world into the vibrant city Linz to take part in an international project.



The course engages students in an international project and offers tools for analyzing and enhancing intercultural communication competence in different contexts and situations. The course is suitable for all study fields and study levels.

The 3 ECTS course comprises of meeting on-line and a live intensive week in Linz, Austria:

- First on-line meeting on 11 May 2026 at 8:30 - 10.00 CET
- Second on-line meeting on 18 May 2026 at 8:30 - 10.00 CET
- Live contact teaching week in Linz 1-5 June, 2026

During the week in Linz, the social programme ensures that you will get the most out of your experience by getting to know Linz and Austria and by creating unforgettable memories with your fellow students.



The course and the social programme are free of charge for the participating students. Students must pay for their travel expenses, accommodation and meals, etc. Students from Europe should check with their home universities for possible Erasmus BIP-funding and/or BIP-status
